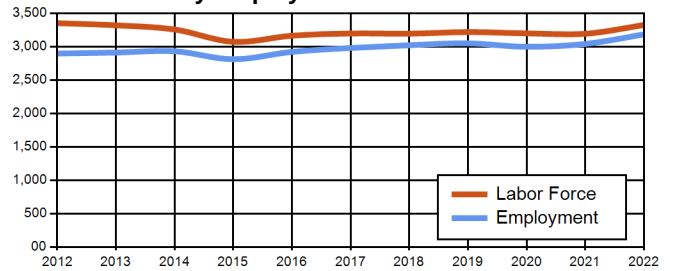

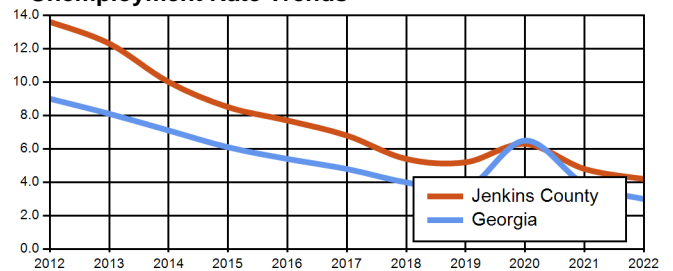

Unemployment Rate Trends

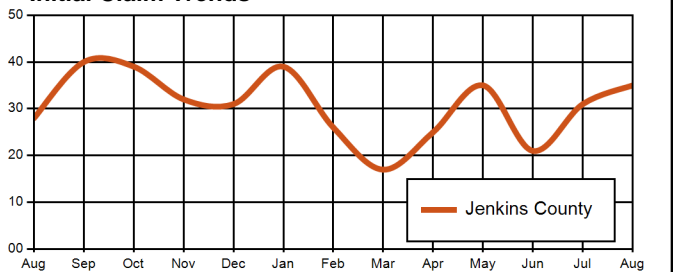

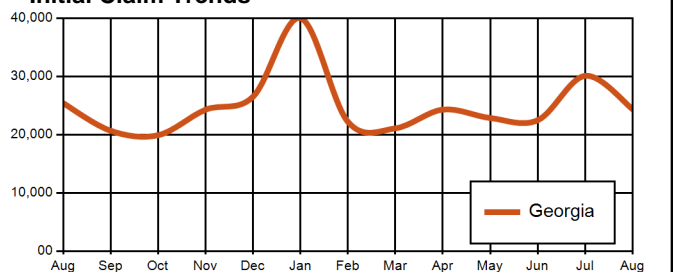

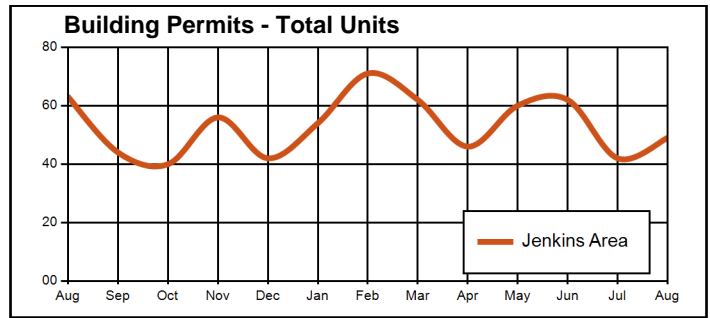

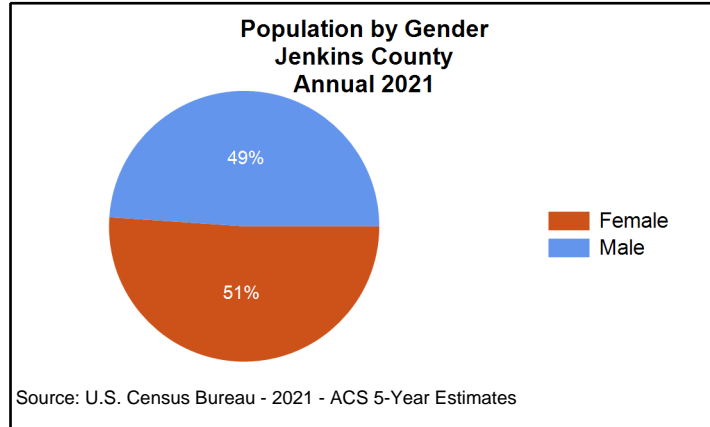

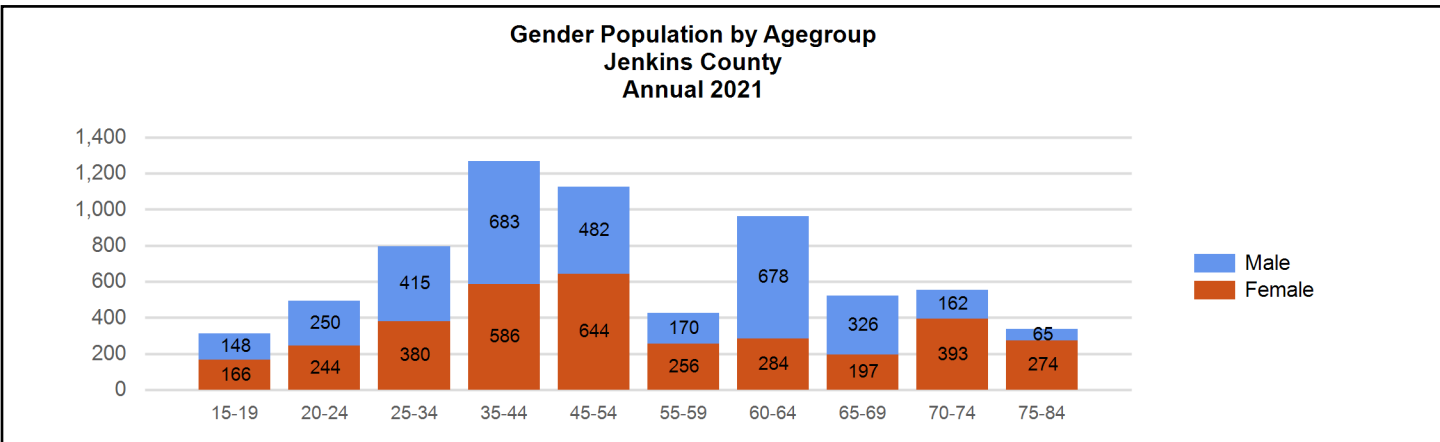

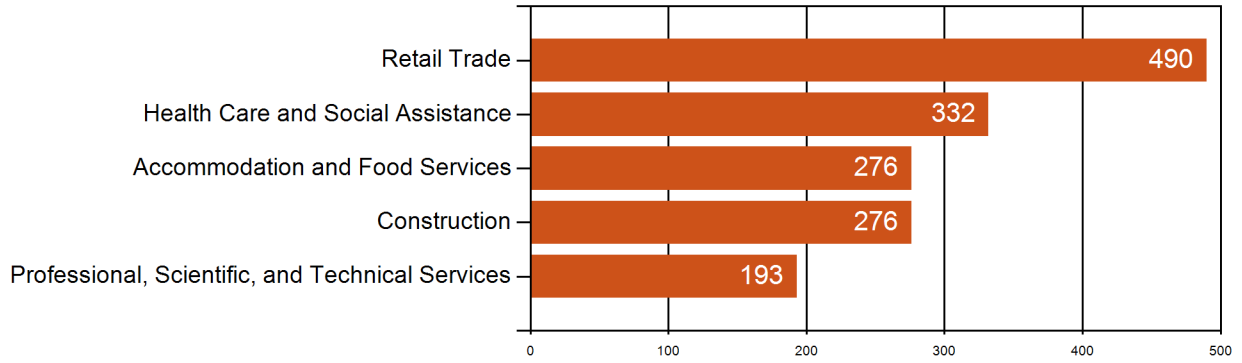

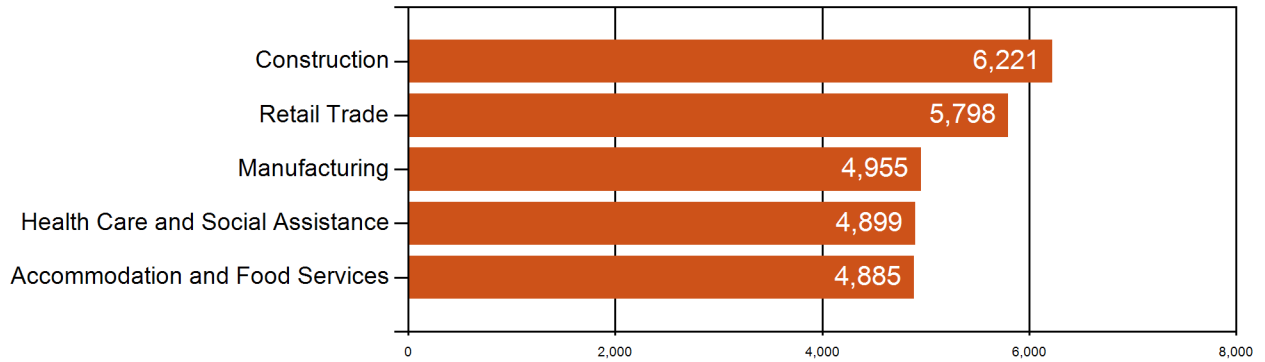
Top Industries - 1st Quarter of 2022

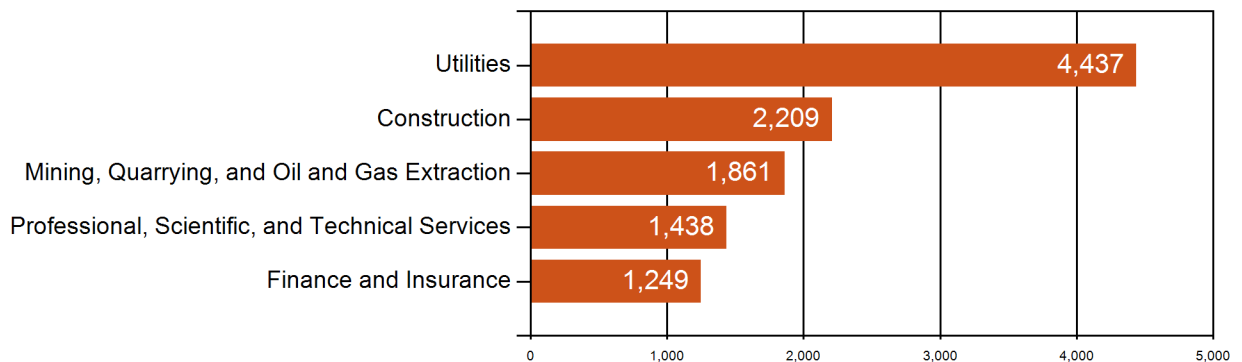
Top Industries by Firms
