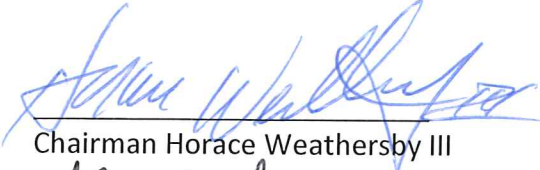


Called Meeting Minutes
Jenkins County Board of Commissioners
Thursday, September 28, 2023
6:00 P.M.

1. The Jenkins County Board of Commissioners held a Called Meeting on Thursday, September 28, 2023, at 6:00 P.M. in the Commissioners' Meeting Room at the James L. Henry Administrative Building. Commissioners in attendance were Chairman Horace Weathersby III, Pamela Dwight, Jonathan Powell, and Tracie Coney. Commissioner Hiller Spann was not in attendance. County Administrator Grady Saxon, Mrs. Deborah Bennett, and Mrs. Sue Gillis were also present.
2. Chairman Weathersby called the meeting to order at 6:00 P.M.
3. Chairman Weathersby read a Resolution of Adoption for the County Operating Budget for 2023/2024 in the amount of \$7,800,479 for the General Fund and a total budget of \$18,683,669. A motion was made by Commissioner Powell and seconded by Commissioner Coney to adopt the County Operating Budget as presented. The motion carried with four votes in favor.
4. Chairman Weathersby read a Resolution of Adoption of the County's Millage Rate of 7.695. A motion was made by Commissioner Powell and seconded by Commissioner Dwight to adopt the County's Millage Rate of 7.695. The motion carried with four votes in favor.
5. Chairman Weathersby read a Resolution of Adoption of the Combined Millage rate of 21.695, which is 7.695 for the County and 14.000 for the Board of Education. A motion was made by Commissioner Powell and seconded by Commissioner Coney to adopt the combined Millage Rate of 21.695. The motion carried with four votes in favor.
6. Chairman Weathersby stated that when Atlantic Waste Services applied for a landfill permit, it paid \$100,000 as an application fee that would pay for all expenses related to the processing of the application. He stated that after all expenses were deducted (\$22,356.38), the County owed a refund to Atlantic Waste in the amount of \$77,643.62. A motion was made by Commissioner Powell and seconded by Commissioner Dwight to remit the refund to Atlantic Waste Services in the amount of \$77,643.62. The motion carried with four votes in favor.
7. The Board members signed all necessary documents.
8. Chairman Weathersby adjourned the meeting at 6:08 P.M.

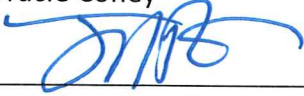
